School Meals-Important

Thank you to all those parents who have registered their child's lunch choices via Arbor. It would be helpful to remind your child each day what meal they will be having for lunch.

If your child is a vegetarian then you must request the vegetarian option.

If your child is bringing a packed lunch from home we still require you to add this in the system. **Your**




