We're delighted to introduce Miss Brown, our new Elephant Class teacher, who has seamlessly integrated into the Year 1 team.


This term promises a wealth of exciting events and learning opportunities for our pupils, including educational visits, Sports Day, class photos, and special visitors to the school.

School Absence-Important Procedures

Please could all parent/carers ensure <u>they let the office know every day</u> that their child is unwell and the nature of the illness. Medical evidence may be required for absences longer than 5 days and when attendance falls below 90%.

Please also provide written proof of any appointments and advise whether your child will be requiring a school meal.

May we also remind you that if your child has vomiting and/or diarrhoea, you must wait 48

hours from the last episode before bringing your child back to school.

There are a number of children who are refusing milk at break time. If your child is 5 years or older and you are paying for their milk, please have a conversation with your child to see whether they still require milk? If you wish to cancel your subscription you will need to contact coolmilk.com

Our milk supplier has recently changed the packaging of the milk from cartons to plastic bottles which are not as popular with our children. 
