

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Goldilocks and the three bears. This week, we listened to the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We retold the story and acted it out with props in class. We had lots of discussions on 'Golden choices' and linked them to our Golden Rules.

Number: This week we have been sorting objects using the language 'same' and 'different'. We have explored sorting techniques and children have created different rules along the way. Can you make a sorting rule for the buttons picture on the right? E.g. do they have the same colour/ same shape/ some size etc... Can you try this with different objects at home e.g. lego pieces, conkers/ leaves/ pebbles, cuddly toys, etc..
