

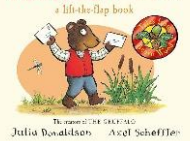
Year R Learning News

English: As part of our celebrations topic, we have spent the fortnight looking at books about birthday parties. We have thought about birthday celebrations we have been to and how we have celebrated birthdays within our families.
