

Year R Learning News




Our story of the week has been *The Naughty Bus*, the tale of a very cheeky toy bus that goes on adventures exploring the world around us. The Naughty Bus is a red London bus and we have been thinking about where it might travel. We have been thinking about places in London and imagined where else we could travel to on a bus, both real and magical. We retold the stories together and through our play, and used our ideas to make models and create pictures and paintings.










Maths: In maths we have been

exploring the numbers 6, 7 and 8; we have used resources to think about how these numbers can be represented and how they can be made of different parts. We have been looking at 1 more and 1 less and using stories and songs to help us. This week, we have also learnt about doubling to 8 and that doubling means 'twice as many'. We even saw what happened when objects went into a magic doubling pot - twice as many came out! Can you make your own magic doubling pot at home? If you put 2 apples in, can your child tell you how many would come out? What about 4 lego bricks? Or 3 pencils?
