Phonics Focus

Hello everyone and Happy Friday! This week we have been learning 4 new phonemes (sounds) in our phonics sessions. The children have been absolutely amazing! Can your child practise saying each sound at home? Can they form the letter shape in the air with their finger and say the handwriting formation phrase?



We say 'iiii'

'Down the iguana's body, then draw a dot at the top' Can your child think of any words that start with these phonemes? E.g. 'nnnnnnnet' or 'd d dog'.



We say 'nnnnnnnn'

Down the stick, up and over the net'



We say 'mmmmmmm'

"Down, up and over the mouse's ears then add a flick on the nose"



We say 'd d d'

"Round the duck's body, up to its head and down to its feet"
